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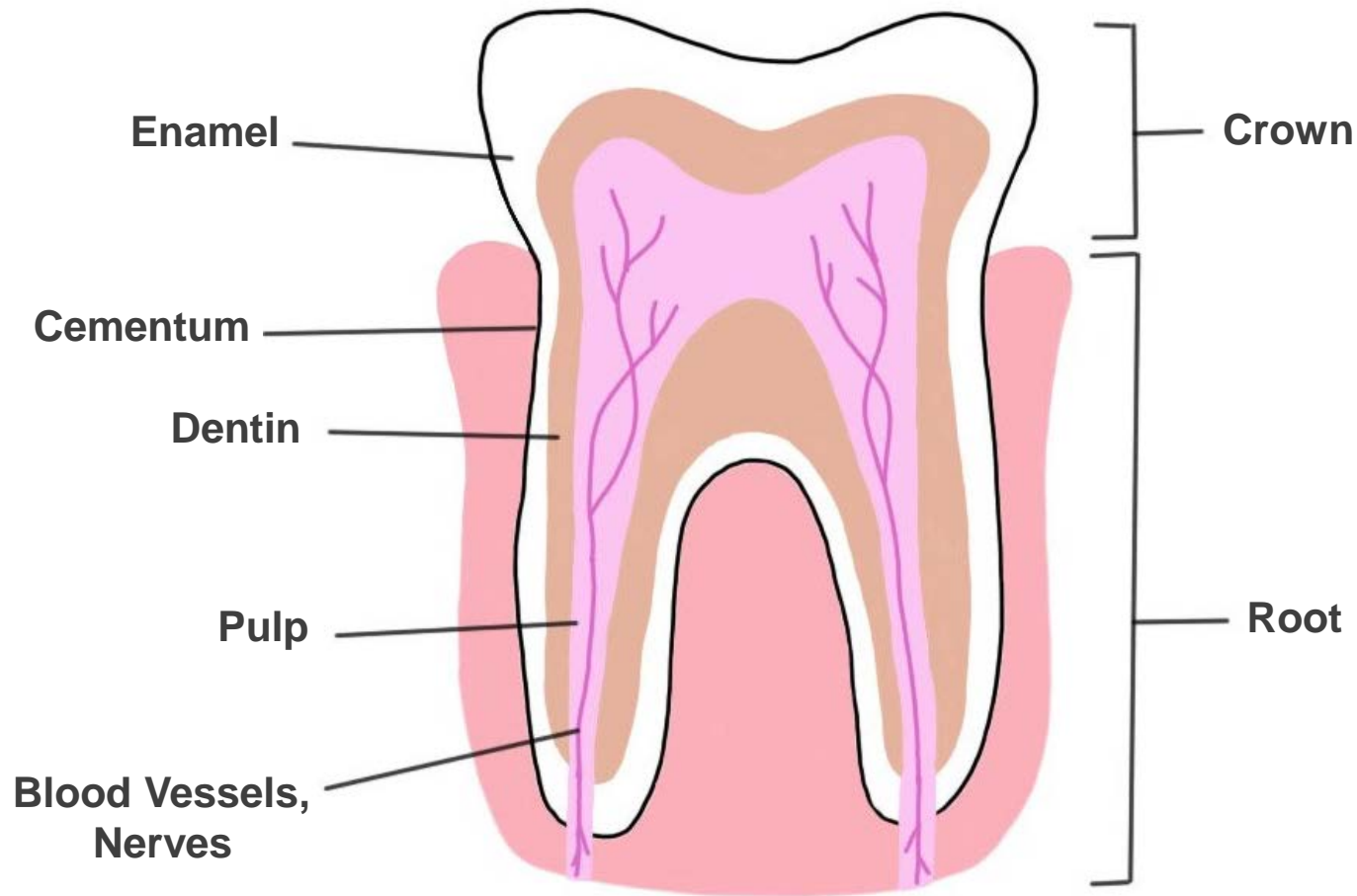

IMPACT OF POOR ORAL HEALTH ON SCHOOL

- 59% of adolescents age 12 to 19 have had dental caries (tooth decay) in their permanent teeth
- 20% of adolescents age 12 to 19 have untreated decay
- Per 100 high school-aged adolescents, 80 school hours are missed annually due to needed dental care
